



Gauge' s Stripy Biased Scarf

Materials:

Yarn A 1 ball noro, silk garden

Yarn B 1 hank berroco, ultra alpaca fine

US 10 needles

tbl - through the back loop

kfandb - knit into front and back of stitch = 1 stitch increased

pfandb - purl into front and back of stitch = 1 stitch increased

k2tog- knit 2 together

p2tog-purl 2 together

yf- yarn forward - pull yarn forward between your needles

rs - right side

f.y.i.: **1.**you will maintain a selvedge on this scarf as follows **knit first stitch through the back loop** and after working across row **yarn forward and slip as if to purl**. **2.** This may seem obvious but once you have joined in Yarn B, you are going to pull the yarns up the side inside the selvedge/1 stitch in when you change color.

Cast on 25 with yarn A and work the next 2 rows

Row 1 (RS): knit (do not forget your selvedge)

Row 2: Knit first stitch through the back loop (tbl) knit 1, k2tog, yf and slip as if to purl, knit to last 3 stitches, k2tog, yf and slip as if to purl

Row 3: switch to Yarn B, knit row

Row 4: work selvedge st, Purl 1, p2tog, yf slip as if to purl, purl to last 3 stitches, p2tog, yf slip as if to purl

Repeat these 4 rows switching colors every two rows. End with row 2. Bind off.
